- o Community traffic sign: City and 311 have been contacted. Discussions are ongoing.
- Sept 20th pedestrian accident: A combination of factors led to the accident. Suggestion has been made to add a bar to the southeast corner of 25th Avenue and Erlton Street to encourage pedestrians to cross at the crosswalk.
- <u>Permit Parking</u>: Permit parking fees will take effect in January 2023 for permit holders. Fees for street parking range from \$15/year for some households to \$100/month for condo owners. Discussion of distribution of this information along with the City Councilors to contact. Possibilities include entry into local flyer, ECA website, posters in condo elevators, individual letters. Dylan to contact MLA Mclean for a letter of support.
